Purpose: To encourage CNUSD students to continue their education at an institution of higher learning such as a trade school, technical school, college, or university.

Criteria: **Education and Career Goals**
 1. Applicant should have post-high school education goals and a career path.

GPA
 2. Applicant should have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater.

Citizenship and Leadership
 3. Applicant should demonstrate citizenship or leadership ability such as:

- Serve or work within a leadership role on campus
- Involvement in community service organizations
- Participation in extra-curricular activities

Letter of Introduction and Interest
 4. Applicant must prepare a letter of introduction and interest including:

- Which school does the student anticipate attending
- Scholastic and past achievements
- Volunteer and leadership opportunities
- Future goals and career path
- How this scholarship will assist in obtaining these future goals

Application Procedure: Applicant must submit the completed application form and letter of introduction and interest to the high school’s counseling office according to the school’s deadline.

Disbursement: In order to claim a CNMA scholarship, students must present proof of enrollment status, class schedule, proof of payment receipt and a valid ID to:

If the scholarship is not claimed on or before June 30 of the following year, the allocated fund will be returned to the scholarship fund.

If extenuating circumstances exist, the student may request a one-time, one-year extension. Such requests must be in writing, explain the circumstances, and be received by Mirna Romero, CNMA Scholarship Coordinator, on or before June 30, of the year following the award presentation. The CNMA Executive Board will review the request and will notify the student if the request can be granted.
